
Pattern for *Gyôyô*. (Actual size)



The patterns are for the left *gyôyô* (and show the front.) Reverse the patterns for a right side *gyôyô*.

Fold over on the dotted blue line, and lightly dish the body.

The better ones are covered in patterned leather and rimmed with a gilt *fukurin* (the latter

in two pieces — one for the angled top, and one for the body of the $gy\hat{o}y\hat{o}$).

Instead of (or in addition to) the leather facing, you can apply an embossed crest or simply paint one on the lacquered surface. All are common methods of dressing up a *gyôyô*.

Cords attach to the watagami.
